MEMBERSHIP RULES & REGULATIONS

Memberships are purchased on a seasonal basis. The Oneonta Tennis Club has three seasons and each season is four months long; Fall-Winter, Winter-Spring and Summer.

The Oneonta Tennis Club is a privately owned membership facility. Membership is required to participate in the programs at the Club.

Open court fees

Prime time (Mon- Thu 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.) \$60 per hour per court

Non-prime time - \$50 per hour per court.

Seasonal reservations are encouraged and will receive first priority over other events at the Club.

Lesson and clinics will be offered throughout the season by Paul van der Sommen.

You can purchase an “All You Can Play Pass” for the season. It includes all open court fees, league fees and 30% off on all lesson, clinic fees, pro shop items, and season contract.

The facility hours during the fall season are daily from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Reservations are required. **Players cannot play without a reservation.** A reservation requires a minimum of two members’ names. A reservation can be up to 2 hours for doubles and 1-1/2 hour for singles. A singles reservation is not allowed to become a doubles reservation. A player is allowed two reservations at the time. Cancellations within 24 hours of play will incur a \$25 (per group) cancellation fee.

Day or Date, Time, Description and Last Names! (I.e. Tuesday February 31 – 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. d1.5 – Federer – Sampras – Agassi – Obama)

Court fees have to be paid in advance at the time of the reservation. Invoices will be sent at the time of the reservation via the internet to members who do not have an “An All You Can Play Pass”. Reservations are not confirmed until full payment has been received.

Membership is not transferrable. Each individual member is allowed to bring in an associate member who has not been a member in the last two years. The member will decide the membership fee for the associate and will keep the money. Members who have joined as a 2-person, family or student are allowed to bring in 2 or more or as a student.

Members are required to enter their membership number in our front door entrance keypad to access the indoor facility. All entries to the facility and play are recorded on our security system. Members who do not use their own number to enter will have their membership suspended.

Members can invite guests to play. Guests can use the facility upon approval of the management. Guest can play at the facility 3 times during the season. Daily guest fees and regular court fees will apply.

Members are financial responsible for the guests.

Throughout the day there are no attendants on duty. In case of medical emergency please call 911.
